

## Fall 2023 and Spring 2024 College of Technology Open House and Career Expo Scholarship Vouchers and Door Prizes

There were approximately \$20,000 in scholarship vouchers and other door prizes available for Fall and Spring 2023-24 Open House and Career Expos. All students registered for either the in-person open house or the virtual open house had access to the virtual open house website, which is where students qualified to receive these rewards.
