PSU History

1903: Pittsburg State University opens its doors as the Kansas State Manual Training Normal School Auxiliary on September 8th with 54 students and 5 faculty members in the Central School Building located at Fifth and Walnut.

1904: The Alumni Association is organized on June 6th.

1905: The state legislature appropriates funds to purchase the original campus site of 17 acres.

1906: The tradition of a senior class gift begins with the gift of a full-sized reproduction of Nike, the Winged Victory. The statue was destroyed in the 1914 Russ Hall fire.

1907: Construction begins on what becomes Russ Hall, the first building on campus. The celebration to commemorate the state appropriation is now commonly referred to as Apple Day.

1908: The first yearbook is published. The first football game is played on October 2nd against Pittsburg High School.

1909: The first alumni banquet is held in June.

1910: The first student newspaper, the "Manual Normal Light" is published.

1913: The School is granted administrative independence from the State Normal School at Emporia, and the term Auxiliary is dropped from the name.

1914: A tragic fire destroys most of Russ Hall on June 29th. Rex Tanner, a student, is killed when he comes into contact with a fallen electrical line.

1923: The State Manual Training Normal School is granted full college accreditation and is renamed the Kansas State Teachers College of Pittsburg.

1925: The gorilla is selected by the student body as the mascot of the athletic teams. The name comes from an all-male pep squad first organized in 1920.

1940: William A. Brandenburg, president since 1913, dies in October while still in office. During his tenure, campus buildings increase from two to 13, faculty increase from 40 to 140, and student enrollment grows from 450 to 1,350.

1953: Kansas State College celebrates the 50th anniversary of its founding. Radio and recording artist, Vaughan Monroe, is on hand in October to feature the College in a nationwide radio show originating from Carney Hall auditorium.

1955: The men's basketball team places third at the national NAIA tournament and Coach John Lance is elected NAIA coach of the year.

1957: Pittsburg wins the national NAIA championship in football under the direction of Carnie Smith. Pitt defeated Hillsdale College of Michigan in the Holiday Bowl with a score of 27 to 26.

1959: The College's name changes to Kansas State College of Pittsburg.

1961: Carnie Smith leads the Gorillas to their second national football title.

1962: Russell S. Russ, the founder and first administrator of the College dies at his home in Muskogee, Oklahoma, at the age of 102.

PSU History

1968: Debra Dene Barnes, a music major from Moran, Kansas, reigns as Miss America.

1974: In their first year of intercollegiate competition, the women athletes compile records of 8-12 in volleyball, 0-10 in basketball, and 12-5 in softball.

1977: University status is granted in January, completing the institution's transition from School to College to Pittsburg State University.

1981: Shirley Christian, a 1960 graduate, receives the 1980 Pulitzer Prize for international reporting for articles from El Salvador and Guatemala that appeared in the Miami Herald.

1989: Pittsburg State moves from NAIA competition in athletics to NCAA Division II status.

1991: Pittsburg State University wins the national championship in football with a win over Jacksonville State.

1997: Dedication of the Kansas Technology Center takes place in October.

2003: A 15-month celebration of the Pittsburg State University centennial begins in February.

2004: On Memorial Day, the PSU Veterans Memorial was dedicated.

2008: The Student Recreation Center is opened to students and faculty members in August.

2009: The Bryant Student Health Center was dedicated on Family Day, September 26th. Steven A. Scott was inaugurated as the ninth president of PSU.

2010: The newest residence hall, Crimson Commons, was opened in the fall.

2011: In his second year as head coach, Tim Beck, leads the Gorillas to win the NCAA Division II National Football Championship.

2013: The first renovation phase of the Weede Physical Education Building is completed and Whetzel Court is dedicated. Groundbreaking for the new Center for the Arts takes place.

2014: Dedication ceremony for the Bicknell Family Center for the Arts occurs.

2015: Dedication ceremonies were held for the Robert W. Plaster Center and for the expansion of the Jack H. Overman Student Center.

2016: Irene Ransom Bradley School of Nursing conducts first White Coat Ceremony. Women's outdoor track and field team wins NCAA Division II National Championship.

2017: PSU and City of Pittsburg hold groundbreaking for Block22 downtown restoration.

2018: PSU Men's Indoor Track & Field team wins NCAA DII Indoor Championship. PSU holds first TEDx event with 10 diverse speakers. PSU mourns its biggest cheerleader Jack Overman, who passed away at the age of 100.

2019: Community celebrates the completion of Block22 with the opening of restaurants.

Iralene Swain



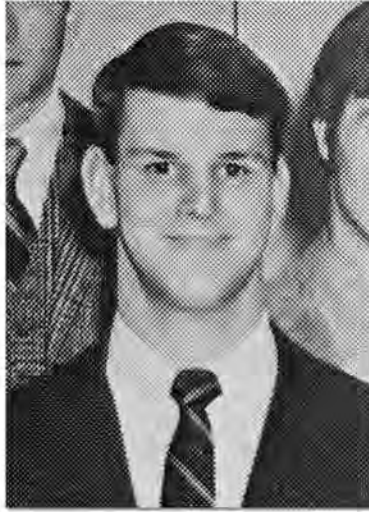
