Last Thursday, Dean Grimes toured Whitesitt, FCS, and Hartman as part of AA Master Planning Committee – Provost Bon familiarizing with buildings and wanting to scout potential landing sites for Kelce “hoteling space” for use after our move downtown; will tour Grubbs, Horace Mann, and Porter next week.
