Kelce Leadership Team Meeting

October 16, 2013, 1:00 p.m.

The agenda for Dr. Ron Berry's visit to PSU and Kelce on Thursday was discussed. Assurance of Learning / Assessment committee will need to discuss with Dr. Berry the process of assessment at PSU, not actual results.
