My research focuses primarily on the individual and societal impacts of economic and financial education, labor markets, sports, and public policy.

Impact

While the long-term impact of my research on other academics is evidenced through the various research awards I have received, including the Villard Research Award from the National Association of Economic Education for my career contributions to the economics education literature, the most important and far reaching impact is one that changed public policy. Research I conducted earlier in my career while Director for the Center for Economic Education and Financial Literacy at Mississippi State University was used to justify a change in the state mandated high school curriculum to require

a course in economics and personal finance prior to graduation. This has impacted the lives of all citizens in the state of Mississippi and will continue to do so for generations.
