

SEXUAL ASSAULT NURSE EXAMINER CLINICAL COURSE

According to the Rape, Abuse & Incest National Network, **every 68 seconds, there is a sexual assault in the United States.** Sexual Assault Nurse Examiners (SANEs) are the ones called to emergency rooms and urgent care centers to interview, collect evidence and document the findings of these assaults.

This adult/adolescent Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner (SANE) clinical simulation training program is geared toward the Registered Nurse or Advanced Practice Registered Nurse planning on practicing in the role of SANE. This clinical course will assist students in becoming competent in the performance of the adult/adolescent sexual assault medical forensic examination. Students must have a minimum of an RN license before beginning this course. This course meets the International Association of Forensic Nurses (IAFN) SANE Education Guidelines and provides 16 contact hours in nursing upon completion. The 40 hour adult/adolescent Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner (SANE) didactic course must be completed prior this clinical course.
