
Resources for Sexual & Intimate Partner Violence

Quick Reference Guide



Medical

- Survivors are highly encouraged to seek confidential medical care after any assault.
- Evidence collection by a Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner (SANE) is available at Ascension Via Christi Hospital and the Bryant Student Health Center up to 96 hours after a sexual assault at no cost to the survivor.
- Preventative medication for sexually transmitted infections and/or pregnancy is available.
- Evidence can be collected without reporting and is stored for five years.

Reporting & Safety

- All students affected by sexual or intimate partner violence are encouraged to file reports.
- Police: Students have the option to provide criminal or informational report only.
- Institutional Equity and/or Student Life: Students have the option to report and/or participate in a voluntary internal campus investigation. There are also support measures available for students.

Education & Prevention

- Educational and interactive presentations and trainings for students, faculty, and staff on a variety of topics related to sexual assault and intimate partner violence are available at no cost:
 - > Healthy Relationships
 - > Sexual Communication & Consent
 - > Stalking
 - > Human Trafficking
 - > Bystander Intervention
 - > Trauma Informed Response
 - > Intimate Partner Violence Prevention

Counseling & Advocacy

- Campus Victim Advocate: Provides free and confidential advocacy services including crisis intervention, safety planning, support groups, Title IX assistance, reporting assistance, court accompaniment, medical advocacy, education, and referrals.
- Safehouse Crisis Center: Provides free and confidential advocacy services like the campus victim advocate with the addition of temporary emergency shelter, 24/7 hotline crisis intervention, and 24/7 textline.
- Safehouse Counseling Service: Provides free and confidential counseling from a licensed therapist.
- Counseling: No and low cost therapeutic resources for both acute and historical assault are available on and off campus.
