

Reading Standards: New Kansas/IRA

Standard 1: Candidates create and engage their students in literacy practices that develop awareness, understanding, respect, and a valuing of differences in our society.

Standard 2: Candidates create a literate environment that fosters reading and writing by integrating foundational knowledge, instructional practices, approaches and methods, curriculum materials and the appropriate use of assessments.

Standard 3: Candidates understand the theoretical and evidence-based foundations of reading and writing processes and instruction.

Standard 4: Candidates use instructional approaches, materials, and an integrated, balanced curriculum to support student reading and writing.

Standard 5: Candidates use a variety of assessment tools and practices to plan and evaluate effective reading and writing instruction.

Standard 6: Candidates recognize the importance of, demonstrate, and facilitate professional learning and leadership as a career long effort and responsibility.
